WELCOME AND CALL TO ORDER

Chairman David Kenner called the Executive Committee Meeting to order at 12:00 PM.

ADOPTION OF AGENDA

APPROVAL OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MINUTES

PRESENTATION OF DRAFT FINANCIAL STATEMENT OF OPERATIONS

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Dr. Molnar presented the Executive Director's report:

- Employee Match and Retiree OPEB We currently have 32 full time employees, with 15 employees in total in the deferred compensation match program including 5 who increased their contribution and 4 new employees. Regarding the OPEB, we forwarded what the board voted on last August to the attorney in September and he explained that there are some issues with what was finally passed by the board. He was making corrections and then went missing due to a family situation in December. We are now working with another labor attorney and should have clarity soon.

- SC Department on Aging/COAs
- Roof Repair We placed a call for bids last week. A mandatory pre-bid meeting was held in early January where 7 contractors attended, including a few known to our engineer. An addendum will go out next week because we are trying to use Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funds to pay for part of the cost, up to \$250K. If not, we will try to use it for HVAC and electrical work later. The bid opening is Monday, January 25th at 11AM. We asked for three extra copies of bids. Board member Marvin Dueck is reviewing the bids for us and our engineer will give us his recommendation. I would like the Executive Committee to approve the selected bid winner so we can move on to the contract phase.
- LSCOG Board of Directors' Meeting is on February 10, 2022, in Orangeburg.
